Official Troop Policy For:

Boards of Review

Troop One Board of Review Policy



Review for First Class Through Life Ranks and Eagle Palms - After a Scout has completed all requirements for First Class, Star, and Life ranks, or an Eagle Palm, he appears before a Board of Review (BoR). A Board of Review is made up of at least three (3) members of the Troop Committee.

✓ All Boards of Reviews (BoR) must be scheduled at least two (2) weeks in advance so as to allow the Scout and Adult Leaders time to prepare. Scout should make the necessary arrangements with Troop One Junior Asst. Scoutmaster or in his absence, the Asst. Scoutmaster.

✓ Scout must have all merit badges and rank advancement requirements completed before a Board of Review can be scheduled. See Troop One Advancement Chairman to determine if you are eligible.

✓ The Scout should present himself to the Board of Review as neat in appearance and his uniform should be as correct as possible, with the badges worn properly, and neckerchief. For LIFE and EAGLE BoR's, good shoes (no sneakers) and scout pants or dress pants (no jeans, sweat pants, gym shorts or the like)

 \checkmark The Scout is responsible for bringing the following to the BoR:

a) Scout Handbook with all rank advancement information completed and signed by an adult leaders

b) A list of all his merit badges earned to date.

- c) A list of all Troop Camping Trips and other events they have attended during the past year.
- d) List of current and past service projects they have worked on for rank advancement.
- e) List of past and current leadership positions held within the Troop.

Failure to bring the above items (a, b, c, d, and e) will result in the Board of Review being rescheduled.

 \checkmark The BoR should take approximately fifteen to twenty minutes.

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
